Explanation of Bankruptcy Discharge in a Chapter 7 Case

This order does not close or dismiss the case, and it does not determine how much money, if any, the trustee will pay creditors.

Creditors cannot collect discharged debts

This order means that no one may make any attempt to collect a discharged debt from the debtors personally. For example, creditors cannot sue, garnish wages, assert a deficiency, or otherwise try to collect from the debtors personally on discharged debts. Creditors cannot contact the debtors by mail, phone, or otherwise in any attempt to collect the debt personally. Creditors who violate this order can be required to pay debtors damages and attorney's fees.

However, a creditor with a lien may enforce a claim against the debtors' property subject to that lien unless the lien was avoided or eliminated. For example, a creditor may have the right to foreclose a home mortgage or repossess an automobile.

This order does not prevent debtors from paying any debt voluntarily or from paying reaffirmed debts according to the reaffirmation agreement. 11 U.S.C. § 524(c), (f).

Most debts are discharged

Most debts are covered by the discharge, but not all. Generally, a discharge removes the debtors' personal liability for debts owed before the debtors' bankruptcy case was filed.

Also, if this case began under a different chapter of the Bankruptcy Code and was later converted to chapter 7, debts owed before the conversion are discharged.

In a case involving community property: Special rules protect certain community property owned by the debtor's spouse, even if that spouse did not file a bankruptcy case.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

Between

THE GLOUCESTER TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY

And

TEAMSTERS UNION LOCAL 500

The following represents the Memorandum of Agreement ("MOA") between The Gloucester Township Municipal Utilities Authority ("GTMUA" and/or "Authority") and Teams Local 500 (Union), collectively called "the Parties", for a new collective bargaining agreement. The terms of the March 1, 2014 through February 28, 2018 agreement will remain unchanged and in full force unless otherwise modified, except as listed below:

- 1. <u>Preamble</u>: The term of the new collective bargaining agreement shall be March 1,2018through February 28, 2022.
- 2. Article I Bargaining Unit: Many of these titles are inconsistent with the Civil Services regulations that the GTMUA operates pursuant to. Management is working on Civil Service titles which are in compliance with Civil Service regulations. This will have no financial impact but is simply designed to bring the GTMUA into full compliance with proper Civil Service required titles. The following titles are hereby added:

Management reserves the right to incorporate title changes, subject to the conditions set forth herein.

Effective Date: March 1, 2018 Expiration Date: February 28, 2022

- Article X Grievances: All deadlines set forth in the grievance section shall be modified to reflect ten (10) working days, unless a long period has previously been established.
- 4. Article XII Promotions: Pursuant to Civil Services Regulations the following shall apply: Candidates who have successfully passed an open-competitive or promotional examination for a specific job title are placed on an eligible list. The eligible lists for open-competitive announcements rank candidates based on residency, veterans' status, and by final average. For example, residents are ranked ahead of non-residents and veterans are ranked ahead of non-veterans.

The eligible lists for promotional announcements rank candidates based on a combination of factors, (i.e., testing mode, seniority, performance evaluation). Most eligible lists have a three-year duration. State and local governmental agencies use these lists to fill job vacancies. They must follow the "Rule of Three" when appointing candidates to a position.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

Add to the appropriate location the following: Each employee shall be entitled to an hourly increase in pay upon attainment of the following: C-1 License: \$0.50 per hour; C-2 License: \$0.75 per hour; C-3 License: \$1.00 per hour; and C-4 License: \$1.50 per hour.

6. Article XIII - Sick Leave:

Add at the beginning of paragraph two: "All new employees shall not acquire sick leave days until sixty (60) working days of service. For the balance of the new employees first year with the Authority, all sick leave shall be accumulated at a rate, after the initial sixty (60) day period, of one (1) per month for the balance of said employees first year of employment."

Add to paragraph seven: "In no event shall any employee receive in excess of \$15,000 upon retirement in good standing from service with the Authority for sick leave."

7. Article XVII - Funeral Leave:

Add: The use of funeral leave shall be taken consecutively and within one week of the death of the next-of-kin set forth herein. Any exceptions hereto, may be requested in writing to the Executive Director who shall have the authority to waive this requirement in his/her sole discretion.

Also add: "Civil Union Partner" to the list of immediate family members.

8. Article XXVI - Vision and Safety Glass Program:

Shall increase as follows:

Yr. 1: \$225

Yr. 2: \$250

Yr. 3: \$275

Yr. 4: \$300

- Article XXII Longevity: Delete: Paragraphs three (3) through the end of the page in its entirety from: "seniority policy" through "for medical reasons." This example serves no purpose and is no longer applicable.
- 10. Article XVIII Insurance: Tier 4 of Chapter c.78 reimbursement progression shall remain in full force for the full duration of the agreement. However, the Authority shall incorporate Pre-Taxed Deduction (Stipend) as follows: Family Coverage: \$1,000.00 annually; Member/Spouse/Partner or Parent/Children Coverage: \$750.00 annually; Single Coverage: \$500.00 annually.
- 11. Article XVIII Insurance: In the event of a significant change in law that mandates modifications or otherwise impacts the Insurance Provisions as set forth in item paragraph 10., above, the Union and GTMUA agree to reopen negotiations to consider appropriate modification(s), if any, in good faith.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

12. Article XXXIII - Salaries:

Year 1: \$0.60 or 3%, whichever is greater. Year 2: \$0.60 or 3%, whichever is greater. Year 3: \$0.60 or 3%, whichever is greater. Year 4: \$0.60 or 3%, whichever is greater.

This agreement is subject to the formal ratification by the membership of Teamster Local 500 as well as the Chairman and Members of the Gloucester Township Municipal Utilities Authority.
