#### I. INTRODUCTION

This office has reviewed all documents provided regarding the bid submissions for the Sewer Rehabilitation project on behalf of the Gloucester Township Municipal Utilities Authority ("GTMUA" and/or "Authority"). The GTMUA received four (4) bids for the specified Contract. The bids were received on Tuesday, June 26, 2018 at 2:00 p.m. as follows:

VENDOR	BID AMOUNT
1. Insituform Technologies, Inc.	\$140,660.00
2. National Water Main Cleaning Company	\$152,185.00
3. Michels	\$154,983.00
4. Standard Pipe Services	\$177,730.00

#### II. FACTUAL ANALYSIS

The apparent low bid for this Contract was submitted by Insituform Technologies, Inc. ("Insituform") with a total base bid in the amount of \$140,660.00. Following review of the bid submitted by Insituform, no apparent defects were uncovered. Via correspondence dated June 27, 2018, Thomas Leisse, PE, CME, Authority Engineer, opined that the bid submitted by Insituform complied with the bid specification. He further provided that Insituform has successfully completed rehabilitation projects for the Authority. Thereafter, Mr. Leisse recommended the award of the contract to Insituform pending Solicitor's concurrence.

#### III. LEGAL ANALYSIS

The Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq. regulates bidding on contracts of public entities in New Jersey. In general, the practice of public bidding is universally recognized and deeply imbedded in the public policy of the State of New Jersey. N.E.R.I. Corp. v. New Jersey Highway Authority, 147 N.J. 223, 236 (1996). There is a prima facie presumption that power and discretion of governmental action in awarding bids on public contracts has been properly exercised. Colonnelli Bros., Inc. v. Village of Ridgefield Park, 284 N.J.Super. 538, 541 (App.Div.1995).

Public bidding statutes are to be construed with sole reference to the public good and rigidly adhered to by courts. Hall Const. Co., Inc. v. New Jersey Sports & Exposition Authority, 295 N.J.Super. 629, 634 (App.Div.1996). Furthermore, public bidding statutes exist for the good of taxpayers, not bidders, and they must always be construed for the public good and to guard against favoritism, improvidence, extravagance, and corruption. Sevell v. New Jersey Highway Authority, 329 N.J.Super. 580, 584 (App.Div.2000).

Every contract awarded by the contracting agent for the provision or performance of any goods or services, the cost of which in the aggregate exceeds the bid threshold, shall be awarded only by Resolution of the governing body of the contracting unit to the lowest responsible bidder after public advertising for bids and bidding therefore. N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4. "Lowest responsible bidder or vendor" means the bidder or vendor: (a) whose response to a request for bids offers the lowest price and is responsive; and (b) who is responsible. N.J.S.A. 40A:11-2. The lowest responsible bidder on a public contract must not only be deemed responsible but must submit the lowest bid which conforms to the contract specifications. Matter of Protest of Award of On-Line Games Production & Operation Services Contract, Bid No. 95-X-20175, 279 N.J.Super. 566, 590 (App.Div.1995).

It is firmly established in New Jersey that material conditions contained in bidding specifications may not be waived. Terminal Const. Corp. v. Atlantic Cty. Sewerage Auth., 67 N.J. 403, 409 (1975). A contracting body is generally without discretion to accept a defective bid. Meadowbrook Carting Co. v. Borough of Island Heights, 138 N.J. 307, 314 (1994). However, while material conditions contained in bidding specifications may not be waived, this rule does not apply to minor or inconsequential conditions. Public contracting units may resolve problems arising from such conditions in a sensible or practical way. Terminal Const. Corp., 67 N.J. at 409-11. Materiality of a particular specification is to be determined as a matter of law. Hanover Tp. v. Inter. Fidelity Ins. Co., 122 N.J.Super. 544, 548 (App.Div.1973).

There are two (2) criteria for determining whether a specific non-compliance constitutes a substantial and, hence, non-waivable irregularity: (1) Whether the effect of a waiver would be to deprive the public body of its assurance that the contract will be entered into, performed, and guaranteed according to its specific requirements; and (2) Whether it is of such a nature that its waiver would adversely affect competitive bidding by placing a bidder in a position of advantage over the other bidders or by otherwise undermining the necessary common standard of competition. Township of River Vale v. R.J. Longo Constr. Co., 127 N.J. Super. 207, 222 (Law.Div.1974).

The court has provided further guidance as to materiality where an error is "patent and the true intent of the bidder obvious". In such a situation, the Appellate Division has held that such an error may be disregarded by the public agency. The Court held that certain non-compliance (i.e. obvious error) with the bid

specifications may be deemed not material and therefore waivable by the public entity. Spina v. Borough of Fairview, 304 N.J. Super. 425, (App. Div. 1997).

The Law requires certain items to be included as material aspects of every bid. The statute reads:

"When required by the bid plans and specifications, the following requirements shall be considered mandatory items to be submitted at the time specified by the contracting unit for the receipt of the bids; the failure to submit any one of the mandatory items shall be deemed a fatal defect that shall render the bid proposal unresponsive and that cannot be cured by the governing body:

- a. A guarantee to accompany the bid pursuant to section 21 of P.L.1971, c.198 (C.40A:11-21);
- A certificate from a surety company pursuant to section 22 of P.L.1971, c.198 (C.40A:11-22);
- c. A statement of corporate ownership pursuant to section 1 of P.L.1977,
   c.33 (C.52:25-24.2);
- d. A listing of subcontractors pursuant to section 16 of P.L.1971, c.198 (C,40A:11-16);
- e. A document provided by the contracting agent in the bid plans, specifications, or bid proposal documents for the bidder to acknowledge the bidder's receipt of any notice or revisions or addenda to the advertisement or bid documents;"

N.J.S.A. 40A:11-23.2.

Finally, a local contracting unit is permitted to reject all bids within a part under certain conditions. N.J.S.A. 40A:11-13.2, provides in pertinent part:

- "A local contracting unit can reject all bids for any of the following reasons:
- a. The lowest bid substantially exceeds the cost estimates for the goods or services;
- b. The lowest bid substantially exceeds the contracting unit's appropriation for the goods or services;
- c. The governing body of the contracting unit decides to abandon the project for provision or performance of the goods or services;

- d. The contracting unit wants to substantially revise the specifications for the goods or services;
- e. The purposes or provisions or both of P.L.1971, c. 198 (C.40A:11-1 et seq.) are being violated;
- f. The governing body of the contracting unit decides to use the State authorized contract pursuant to section 12 of P.L.1971, c. 198 (C.40A:11-12).

N.J.S.A. 40A:11-13.2.

As outlined above, upon review of the bid submitted by Insituform, I did not uncover any defects within the bid. To the extent that a defect exists in the bid submitted by Insituform, it is hereby waived by the Authority pursuant to the Court's rulings in <u>Terminal Const. Corp.</u> and <u>Spina</u>.

WHEREAS, all members of the governing body have received and have familiarized themselves with, at least, the minimum requirements of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey, as stated aforesaid and have subscribed to the affidavit, as provided by the Local Finance Board, and

WHEREAS, failure to comply with the regulations of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey may subject the members of the local governing body to the penalty provisions of R.S. 52:27BB-52, to wit:

R.S. 52:27BB-52: A local officer or member of a local governing body who, after a date fixed for compliance, fails or refuses to obey an order of the director (Director of Local Government Services), under the provisions of this Article, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, may be fined not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisoned for not more than one year, or both, in addition shall forfeit his office.



78. Narrative

On 04/01/18, at approximately 0206 hours, I was dispatched to 1711 Hollywood Ave located in the Hilltop section of Gloucester Twp for a report of an active dwelling fire. Police communication advised that they were on the line with the resident, who was reporting an active bedroom fire.

Upon my arrival, I observed heavy smoke and visible fire coming from the front right side bedroom windows. Ptl. Franz arrived on location prior to my arrival and confirmed that all residents were evacuated. I then spoke with the homeowner, Linda L. Slusher, who advised that her son had woken her up screaming that the house was on fire and they needed to get out. Linda advised that he son, Ronald E. Slusher, advised her that the fire started in his bedroom by an unattended candle.

Chews Landing Fire Department and several surrounding fire departments arrived on location and began actively extinguishing the fire. After approximately 45 minutes all visible fire was knocked down and the fire was placed under control. I then spoke with Chews Landing Fire Department's Fire Marshal, Kenneth Young, and advised him of my conversation with the homeowner.

Fire Marshal Young and myself then interviewed Ronald together about the incident. During our conversation, Ronald advised that he arrived home approximately 1 hour ago after dropping a friend off. Upon arriving home, Ronald advised that he went into his bedroom to smoke a cigarette. Ronald explained that his mother does not like the smell of cigarette smoke and in an attempt to mask the smell Ronald advised that he usually lights a candle while smoking. Ronald advised that he also has an exhaust fan in his window to remove the smoke. Ronald advised that he lit the candle that was on a hospital style table in close proximity to the bedroom window on the delta side of the residence. After lighting the candle Ronald advised that he smoked a cigarette then left the room to get a shower.

Ronald advised that when he left the room the candle was still lit. Ronald then went into the bathroom and took a 20 minute shower. Upon exiting the shower and entering his room, Ronald observed visible fire on the wall closest to the candle and fire was extending up the wall and fanning out across the ceiling of the bedroom. Ronald also explained that the room was filled with thick black smoke. Ronald then woke his mother up and they both exited the residence out the back door. After exiting the residence Ronald advised that he contacted 911.

We then spoke with Lisa, who advised that she arrived home from work this morning at approximately 0030 hours. Upon entering the residence, Lisa advised that Ronald was already home and was cleaning the stove. Lisa advised that this week her ex-husband was getting released from jail and was coming to stay with them. Lisa explained that she was unhappy about the situation but her ex-husband had no where to go. She advised that Ronald had been making cosmetic repairs to the residence in preparation for his fathers arrival. When asked about to night, Lisa advised that upon getting home from work she went to bed for the night. She advised that Ronald was still up when she went to bed. While sleeping, Lisa was suddenly woken up by Ronald in a panic advising the house was on fire. She advised that they exited the residence together, at which time Ronald contacted 911. When asked, Lisa advised that she does not think the fire was intentionally started.

During the investigation, Fire Marshal Young deemed the fire non-suspicious. See his report for further details.
