# **REGULAR MEETING, July 20, 2017**

The Regular Meeting of the Gloucester Township Municipal Utilities Authority was held on Thursday, July 20, 2017, at 7:00 P.M. at the Gloucester Township Municipal Utilities Authority Building, 401 W. Landing Road, Blackwood, New Jersey.

The following members were present: Mr. Calabrese, Mr. Simiriglia, Ms. Guevara, Mr. Pillo, Mr. Bianchini, Mrs. Bradley and Mr. Garbowski.

Also present were Mr. Long, Mr. Brickley, Mr. Applegate, Mr. Leisse, Mr. Carr and Mrs. Hrynio.

Council Liaison Orlando Mercado was also present.

Mr. Kirk Applegate, CPA, RMA, Authority Auditor from Bowman & Company was present during the Workshop Portion of the meeting to go over the February 28, 2017 Audit/Exit Conference and to answer any questions the Commissioners may have.

Mr. Applegate stated that there were no findings in the Audit this year. An excellent job was done by the Finance Staff to make sure they were in compliance with all the State statutes. The accounting records were in really great shape.

A few highlights from the Audit. Debt Service Coverage – net revenues have to be at least 1.1 times the Annual Debt Service. For fiscal year 2017, the Authority's net revenues were 1.71. Net revenues were \$930,000 in excess of what is required. Mr. Applegate stated that we are in good shape financially.

During the course of the year, the 2008 NJEIT Trust Loan was refunded by the Trust. The savings on the principal payments was \$128,000 and the savings on the interest payments was \$105,576.39. That was an advantageous refunding for the Authority.

The 1993 Bonds will be paid off in March, 2018. There are plans to address Capital projects over the next few years along with corresponding financing of those projects.

Mr. Applegate spoke about the impact of GASB 68 & 71, which is the recording of the unfunded pension liability from the State.

The Authority's net position was greater in 2016 due to connection fees. The Authority collected over \$497,000 in 2016 compared to \$230,000 this year.

On the Solid Waste side, the Township has made all required payments.

On another note, on the Agenda this evening, is a resolution to amend this year's current budget. The purpose of the amendment is to pay for the 2017 NJEIT Loan. At the time when we put the budget together, we did not know that the first debt service payment would be due in August, 2018. We filed all the documents preliminary with the State and received approval to amend the budget.

Chairman Calabrese thanked Mr. Applegate for his report.

The Chairman read the commencement statement noting that the meeting was advertised in the Courier Post and The Central Record Newspaper, and notice was placed on the bulletin board of the Township of Gloucester and the Gloucester Township Municipal Utilities Authority; the meeting was recorded.

On motion of Mr. Pillo, second by Mr. Simiriglia, the Minutes of the Regular Meeting of June 15, 2017 were approved.

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#### July 13, 2017

- 1. Xylem technicians continue to be on site to complete the final retrofit stations. All of the new control panel materials have been received by the Authority. Xylem technicians for the new panel installations are scheduled to begin the end of July. My office has reviewed and recommended for approval a partial payment request under separate cover. Xylem has submitted a contract extension request that my office will review with the Authority and the NJDEP. My office is working with the Authority to submit the initial request for reimbursement of the loan funding from the NJDEP.
- 2. On June 15<sup>th</sup>, a force main issue was reported along Clementon Avenue downstream of the pumping station. A section of the ACP force main was cracked and leaking. R.D. Zeuli, Inc. completed the emergency repairs and reconnected the force main. I have recommended payment in the amount of \$9,292.50 to R.D. Zeuli, Inc. for the services provided.
- 3. Advanced Rehabilitation Technologies completed the coating of the Fay Ann bar screen structure on Tuesday, July 11<sup>th</sup> and the Stephens Drive structures on Wednesday, July 12<sup>th</sup>. The Authority and I will review the condition of the collection system in those and other areas for future rehabilitation.
- 4. The Authority has engaged a local electrical contractor to complete the electrical service upgrades at Wye Oaks Pumping Station. Design plans have been submitted to the Construction Office for permitting and panels have been received by the Authority. We are working with the Authority and the Contractor to procure materials for the work in anticipation of receiving the electrical permit.
- Re-bid proposals for the 2017 procurement of Xylem Pumps, Spare Parts and Accessories were received on June 28th. A recommendation has been provided under separate cover.
- 6. Contracts for the 2017 Emergency Repairs to Wastewater Conveyance System, Mains and Laterals and Supplementary Construction Services have been executed and distributed.
- 7. The following application has been reviewed and recommended for approval:
  - Contingent Form C Jarvis Road Major Subdivision, 1271 Jarvis Road (Block 16504, Lot 10, 11 & 12)
