ENGINEER'S REPORT GLOUCESTER TOWNSHIP M.U.A.

October 17, 2019

- 1. Atlantic City Electric and Janney Electric have successfully completed the installation of the new electric service and transformer at the Cherrywood Pumping Station. The station has been running without power quality issues since the installation.
- 2. The Stephen Drive Pump Station Emergency Generator replacement bids were opened on October 8th. A review of the bids has been submitted under separate cover.
- 3. My office has addressed comments from the NJDEP on the Orr Road sewer upgrade TWA. We are awaiting the approved permit to begin construction.
- 4. Contracts for the Heavy Duty Service Truck have been received for execution. My office will schedule a preconstruction meeting to review contract terms and schedule for fabrication.
- 5. The first half of the generator PM services has been completed by Penn Power Systems. The services included visual inspections and load bank testing of the Authority's generator units. A recommendation for payment has been submitted under separate cover.
- 6. On October 17th, the Authority participated in online auctions for electrical supply for their PSE&G and ACE accounts. The Authority will review rates for their contract renewals in 2020.
- 7. The following application has been reviewed and recommended for approval:
 - Form A The Estates at Lakeside, 1075 Williamstown-Erial Road (CR 704) (aka Block 18301, Lots 16, 17 &18)
