# ENGINEER'S REPORT GLOUCESTER TOWNSHIP M.U.A.

#### March 18, 2021

- 1. On February 26<sup>th</sup>, the Authority and my office completed a site walkthrough of the sewer rehabilitation project. The Contractor is applying for road opening permits and scheduling the cleaning and televising of the selected pipelines.
- 2. On March 1<sup>st</sup>, a recommendation for partial payment in the amount of \$20,966.00 was submitted for the supply and delivery of the Stephen Drive Pumping Station generator by Penn Power Systems. The Authority has awarded the installation of the generator to Janney Electrical Contractor, Inc. The work is tentatively scheduled for the week of March 22<sup>nd</sup>.
- On March 1<sup>st</sup>, a recommendation for partial payment in the amount of \$20,987.50 was submitted for the completion of the first half of the 2020 Emergency Generator Maintenance and Inspection Services contract completed by Penn Power Systems.
- My office has completed the technical specifications for the current Emergency Generator Maintenance and Inspection Services contract and respectfully request authorization to advertise.
- My office has provided draft bypass design plans to the NJDOT for the Route 42 bridge project over Blackwood Trail for review. My office is completing the TWA documents for Authority endorsement.
- 6. The following application has been reviewed and recommended for approval:
  - Contingent Form F Garden State Storage, 2530 Sicklerville Road (CR 705) (aka Block 14701, Lot 120)
