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ENGINEER'S REPORT GLOUCESTER TOWNSHIP M.U.A.

July 15, 2021

- The new Erial Road Pumping Station emergency generator was delivered to the site on July 6th. The existing generator was relocated on site and is providing temporary emergency power. The new generator has been installed and is in the process of being wired and connected.
- Vortex Services has completed the cleaning and televising of the sewer mains on the Black Horse Pike, Little Gloucester Road, and Good Intent Road as part of the current rehabilitation project. My office will review the video results of the pipe condition with the Authority and coordinate schedule with Vortex to complete the lining of the gravity pipes. My office and the Authority are coordinating with the County and Gloucester Township Police for scheduling, permitting and traffic control.
- On June 17th, a meeting was conducted with Evoqua to review the Authority's odor control plan. The Authority's odor control systems at the Orr Road and Lakeside pumping stations were placed into service on June 30th.
- My office and the Authority attended a site meeting with the County's design engineer on June 30th to review final design details for the replacement of the Somerdale Road Bridge.
- My office continues to assist the Authority with the implementation of the GIS system
 including obtaining field data and preparing pumping station and manhole inspection
 forms as well as operation and maintenance reports that have been incorporated into the
 software.
- 6. Preliminary design plans for the replacement of gravity piping along Orr Road have been drafted and submitted to the Authority for review.
