



One (1) bid was received on October 4<sup>th</sup> at 2:00pm for the aforementioned project from Evoqua Water Technologies, LLC (Evoqua). Evoqua presently provides the hydrogen sulfide and odor control services to the Authority at the Lincoln Avenue, Orr Road, Lakeside Business Park and Central Avenue Pumping Stations.

Evoqua offered a unit price of point four three seven dollars (\$0.437) per pound of 50% percent Hydrogen Peroxide and a unit price of three dollars and thirty nine cents (\$3.39) per gallon of Bioxide. The unit prices include all equipment, chemicals, monitoring and reporting, as detailed in the specifications.

## I. INTRODUCTION

This office has reviewed the documents provided regarding the bid submission with respect to the Contract for GTMUA-22010 for the Hydrogen Sulfide Control Services contract on behalf of the Gloucester Township Municipal Utilities Authority ("GTMUA" and/or "Authority"). The Authority received one (1) bid for the Contract. The bid was submitted on October 4, 2022, as follows:

#### **50% HYDROGEN PEROXIDE**

## II. FACTUAL ANALYSIS

The apparent low bid for the above referenced contract was submitted Evoqua Water Technologies, LLC. ("Evoqua"). Following my review of the bid, no defects were uncovered, and the bid complied with the specifications from a legal perspective. The bid was reviewed from a technical perspective by the Authority Engineer, Thomas Leisse, PE, CME. Following his review, Mr. Leisse opined via letter dated October 6, 2022 that Evoqua's bid complies with the technical specifications and recommended award of the contract to Evoqua, subject to this office's review.

### III. LEGAL ANALYSIS

**RE: GTMUA-22010** 

**Hydrogen Sulfide Control Services** 

The Local Public Contracts Law, <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:11-1 et seq. regulates bidding on Contracts of public entities in New Jersey. In general, the practice of public bidding is universally recognized and deeply imbedded in the public policy of the State of New Jersey. <u>N.E.R.I. Corp. v. New Jersey Highway Authority</u>, 147 <u>N.J.</u> 223, 236 (1996). There is a prima facie presumption that power and discretion of governmental action in awarding bids on public Contracts has been properly exercised. <u>Colonnelli Bros., Inc. v. Village of Ridgefield Park</u>, 284 <u>N.J.Super</u>. 538, 541 (App.Div.1995).

Public bidding statutes are to be construed with sole reference to the public good and rigidly adhered to by courts. Hall Const. Co., Inc. v. New Jersey Sports & Exposition Authority, 295 N.J.Super. 629, 634 (App.Div.1996). Furthermore, public bidding statutes exist for the good of taxpayers, not bidders, and they must always be construed for the public good and to guard against favoritism, improvidence, extravagance, and corruption. Sevell v. New Jersey Highway Authority, 329 N.J.Super. 580, 584 (App.Div.2000).

Every Contract awarded by the contracting agent for the provision or performance of any goods or services, the cost of which in the aggregate exceeds the bid threshold, shall be awarded only by Resolution of the governing body of the contracting unit to the lowest responsible bidder after public advertising for bids and bidding therefore. N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4. "Lowest responsible bidder or vendor" means the bidder or vendor: (a) whose response to a request for bids offers the lowest price and is responsive; and (b) who is responsible. N.J.S.A. 40A:11-2. The lowest responsible bidder on a public Contract must not only be deemed responsible but must submit the lowest bid which conforms to the Contract specifications. Matter of Protest of Award of On-Line Games Production & Operation Services Contract, Bid No. 95-X-20175, 279 N.J.Super. 566, 590 (App.Div.1995).

It is firmly established in New Jersey that material conditions contained in bidding specifications may not be waived. <u>Terminal Const. Corp. v. Atlantic Cty. Sewerage Auth.</u>, 67 <u>N.J.</u> 403, 409 (1975). A contracting body is generally without discretion to accept a defective bid. <u>Meadowbrook Carting Co. v. Borough of Island Heights</u>, 138 <u>N.J.</u> 307, 314 (1994). However, while material conditions contained in bidding specifications may not be waived, this rule does not apply to minor or inconsequential conditions. Public contracting units may resolve problems arising from such conditions in a sensible or practical way. <u>Terminal Const. Corp.</u>, 67 N.J. at 409-11. Materiality of a particular specification is to be determined as a matter of law. <u>Hanover Tp. v. Inter. Fidelity Ins. Co.</u>, 122 <u>N.J.Super.</u> 544, 548 (App.Div.1973).

There are two (2) criteria for determining whether a specific non-compliance constitutes a substantial and, hence, non-waivable irregularity: (1) Whether the effect of a waiver would be to deprive the public body of its assurance that the Contract will be entered into, performed, and guaranteed according to its specific requirements; and (2) Whether it is of such a nature that its waiver would adversely affect competitive bidding by placing a bidder in a position of advantage over the other bidders or by otherwise undermining the necessary common standard of competition. Township of River Vale v. R.J. Longo Constr. Co., 127 N.J.Super. 207, 222 (Law.Div.1974).

The court has provided further guidance as to materiality where an error is "patent and the true intent of the bidder obvious". In such a situation, the Appellate Division has held that such an error may be disregarded by the public agency. The Court held that certain non-compliance (i.e. obvious error) with the bid specifications may be deemed not material and therefore waivable by the public entity. Spina v. Borough of Fairview, 304 N.J. Super. 425, (App. Div. 1997).

As a matter of law, the Local Public Contract Law requires certain items to be included as material aspects of every bid. The statute reads:

"When required by the bid plans and specifications, the following requirements shall be considered mandatory items to be submitted at the time specified by the contracting unit for the receipt of the bids; the failure to submit any one of the mandatory items shall be deemed a fatal defect that shall render the bid proposal unresponsive and that cannot be cured by the governing body:

- a. A guarantee to accompany the bid pursuant to section 21 of P.L.1971, c.198 (C.40A:11-21);
- b. A certificate from a surety company pursuant to section 22 of P.L.1971, c.198 (C.40A:11-22);
- c. A statement of corporate ownership pursuant to section 1 of P.L.1977, c.33 (C.52:25-24.2);
- d. A listing of subcontractors pursuant to section 16 of P.L.1971, c.198 (C.40A:11-16);
- e. A document provided by the contracting agent in the bid plans, specifications, or bid proposal documents for the bidder to acknowledge the bidder's receipt of any notice or revisions or addenda to the advertisement or bid documents:"

N.J.S.A. 40A:11-23.2.

Finally, a local contracting unit is permitted to reject all bids within a part under certain conditions. N.J.S.A. 40A:11-13.2, provides in pertinent part:

- "A local contracting unit can reject <u>all</u> bids for any of the following reasons:
- a. The lowest bid substantially exceeds the cost estimates for the goods or services:
- b. The lowest bid substantially exceeds the contracting unit's appropriation for the goods or services;

- c. The governing body of the contracting unit decides to abandon the project for provision or performance of the goods or services;
- d. The contracting unit wants to substantially revise the specifications for the goods or services;
- e. The purposes or provisions or both of P.L.1971, c. 198 (C.40A:11-1 et seq.) are being violated;
- f. The governing body of the contracting unit decides to use the State authorized contract pursuant to section 12 of P.L.1971, c. 198 (C.40A:11-12).

N.J.S.A. 40A:11-13.2.

As outlined above, the bid submitted by Evoqua contained no defects and complied with the specifications from a legal and technical perspective. To the extent a defect may be uncovered, it is my legal opinion that any such defect is minor in nature and may be waived by the Authority pursuant to the Court's holdings in <u>River Vale</u> and <u>Spina</u>.

I have reviewed the following information in support of the subject Form D application:

- GTMUA Form D Application Form, undated

- Sheet 1 of 1 Sanitary & Water As-built Plan, Union Square, Block 16504, Lots 10, 11 & 12, signed, sealed and dated 5/26/19.

Copies of these documents are on file at the Authority.

The Applicant constructed a major subdivision consisting of residential development of fifty (50) single family homes. Based on the GTMUA's Rules and Regulations, anticipated wastewater discharge volume is calculated to be:

The Applicant connected the subdivision into the GTMUA collection system through construction of +/- 2,175 linear feet of new 8-inch PVC gravity main and nine (9) precast manholes (7 standard and 2 doghouse) connecting to the existing 12-inch PVC gravity main in Jarvis Road (2 locations), which discharges to the Jarvis Road Pumping Station. Fifty (50) individual laterals were constructed, one to serve each unit.

Consistent with the Applicant's Form B/C approval, the Applicant has installed, at their expense, a permanent bypass connection (valves and chamber) and re-route the Jarvis Road Pumping Station force main west through Peachtree Lane and connect to the gravity system on Sturbridge Drive that has available capacity in that portion of the Authority collection system.

All conditions of the Jarvis Road Force Main re-routing have been resolved, to the satisfaction of Authority Professionals.

The documents submitted with the Form D application are consistent with the standard of care for that of a Form D and I recommend approval of this application contingent upon:

1. Receipt of formal letter of certification from the Applicant's engineer of record that all improvements have been installed in substantial compliance with the quality and content of their design plans and specifications and that all improvements dedicated to the Authority are in the public right of way and/or provided with any required utility easements.

The Applicant has requested that since the subject performance bond has been in-place and maintained in excess of three (3) of the completion and acceptance of the improvements that their requirement to post a two (2) year maintenance bond be waived and their performance bond be released. I do not take exception to this request and recommend their performance bond be released and the maintenance bond requirement waived subject to the Authority acknowledging that all outstanding fees are paid in full.

On Wednesday, September 14, 2022, a sewer main issue was reported near the intersection of Front Street and Woodland Avenue.

The findings were as follows:

- 1. The Authority received a report of a sewer main break from Pioneer Pipe Contractors, Inc. (Pioneer). Pioneer was working on other utilities in the area and observed the issue. The Authority confirmed the break in the 12" gravity main at approximately 7-1/2 feet deep at the connection of a drop manhole.
- 2. Due to the nature of the repair and ability to mobilize quickly, GTMUA engaged Pioneer who immediately responded and coordinated the repair with the Authority.
- 3. Pioneer addressed the issue by installing an 18 foot section of new pipe and replacing the drop at the manhole. See attached photos.

The main issue was an "emergency" and quick response by the GTMUA and Pioneer protected the health and safety of the public.



I have received correspondence dated October 5, 2022 from Authority Engineer, Thomas Leisse, PE, CME, regarding the sewer main issue near the intersection of Front Street and Woodland Avenue. The Gloucester Township Municipal Utilities Authority ("GTMUA" and/or "Authority") received a report of a sewer main break from Pioneer Pipe Contractors, Inc. ("Pioneer"). Due to the nature of the repair and ability to mobilize quickly, the Authority engaged Pioneer who immediately responded and coordinated the repair with the Authority. According to Mr. Leisse, the main issue was an emergency which required immediate action to protect the health and safety of the public.

After reviewing the circumstances in existence, it is my legal opinion that an actual emergency did indeed exist which required immediate action to protect the public health. N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6 provides that no contract shall be entered into on an emergency basis unless the following circumstances have been met:

- 1. An actual or imminent emergency must exist requiring the immediate performance of the service;
- 2. The emergency condition must affect the public's health, safety or welfare and require the immediate performance of the service to alleviate said condition.
- 3. The emergency purchasing procedure may not be used unless the need for services could not have been reasonably foreseen;
- 4. The contract shall be of limited duration as to meet only the immediate needs of the emergency;
- 5. Under no circumstances shall the emergency purchasing procedure be used to enter into a multiyear contract.
