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ENGINEER'S REPORT GLOUCESTER TOWNSHIP M.U.A.

March 17, 2022

- Contracts for the new Brookwood Pumping Station Emergency Generator have been distributed to the Contractor. The preconstruction meeting was conducted on March 15th to kick off the project.
- On February 5th, a lateral issue was reported near 826 Davistown Road in the Township. A section of lateral at a depth of approximately 8 feet collapsed between the main and cleanout. R.D. Zeuli, Inc. completed the emergency repairs by installing a new section of replacement lateral. I have recommended payment in the amount of \$9,258.11 to R.D. Zeuli, Inc. for the services provided.
- 3. On March 3rd, a sewer main issue was reported on Lower Landing Road near American Legion Post 281. A sink hole was identified next to the sanitary manhole on Lower Landing Road. R.D. Zeuli, Inc. completed the emergency repairs by utilizing a Prime Resins foam product injected at the manhole to seal the holes in the pipe and to stabilize the voids in the area. I have recommended payment in the amount of \$8,078.96 to R.D. Zeuli, Inc. for the services provided.
- 4. My office is working with the Authority on the design plans for the Highland Park Pumping Station Emergency Generator Replacement. My office respectfully requests the authorization to advertise the project.
- 5. On March 4th, my office responded to NJDEP design comments in support of the Orr Road Phase II Treatment Works Approval application package. My office will continue to work with the NJDEP review engineer to obtain final TWA approval.
- 6. My office has completed the final review of quantities for the sewer rehabilitation project performed by North American Pipeline Services, LLC (Vortex Services). I have recommended Change Order #2 in the amount of \$9,321.25 to complete de-scaling of heavily encrusted sections of sewer main and accounting for final as-built quantities.
- 7. As discussed with the Engineering Committee, my office will obtain quotes to perform flow testing in the gravity sewer main along Sicklerville Road corridor from the Cobblestone section to the Orr Road Pumping Station to determine capacity in the line for future connections.
