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# ENGINEER'S REPORT GLOUCESTER TOWNSHIP M.U.A.

## September 16, 2021

- The old Erial Road Pumping Station emergency generator has been removed from the station and returned to the MUA yard. The Contractor is awaiting final inspection from the Township Construction Office for the new generator installation. The project will be closed out upon completion of the final inspection.
- My office continues to coordinate with the Authority on GIS mapping updates and assistance with field data collection and providing revisions to the forms in the system as needed.
- 3. My office has reviewed the Somerdale Road Bridge replacement plans with the Authority and provided comments to the County's design engineer. The project is currently scheduled for construction in early 2022.
- 4. Contracts for the 2021 Xylem Pumps, Spare Parts and Accessories contract have been distributed for execution.
- Design plans for the replacement of the current replacement of gravity piping along Orr Road from College Drive have been revised to address comments. My office is preparing TWA documents for execution and submission to NJDEP.
